ENROLMENT IN FRENCH IMMERSION/EXTENDED FRENCH PROGRAMS 2015-2016

TO Program and School Services Committee 27 May 2015

RECOMMENDATION IT IS RECOMMENDED that the report be received.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION

Make every school an effective school.

CONTEXT

The attached charts provide the most recent information on the enrolment status in French Immersion (FI) and Extended French (EF) programs. These programs include Early Immersion, Middle Immersion, Junior Extended and Intermediate Extended. It should be noted that the enrolment situation changes daily depending on parental decisions regarding residence and registration of their children.

In the attached charts, *Accepted* refers to the number of students whose parents have accepted a registration in the program.

Extended French and French Immersion are French-as-a-Second-Language (FSL) programs in which French is not only taught as a subject, but also serves as the language of instruction in other subjects.

In a *French Immersion program*, French must be the language of instruction for a minimum of 50 per cent of the total instructional time at every grade level of the program. In an *Extended French program*, French must be the language of instruction for a minimum of 25 per cent of the total instruction time at every grade level.

SUMMARY

There are 3,169 registrants in SK French Immersion programs for September 2015.

There are 62 SK FI sites, including one new site for September 2015, all of which will be Full Day Kindergarten (FDK). There are 32 Junior Extended French sites, including three new sites with a total of 1,158 registrants for September 2015.

In all four programs referred to in this report (Early Immersion, Middle Immersion, Grade 4 Extended and Grade 7 Extended), all on-time applicants were offered a place in the program of their choice as per PR 597 – French Immersion/Extended French. There are no system wait lists.

When a fraction appears in the "Accepted Redirection" column, the denominator indicates the number of students who were redirected to a school other than the French program school currently associated to their designated English school as per PR 597 – French Immersion/Extended French. The numerator indicates the number of accepted placements through redirection. For example, on the line for Humbercrest "6/7 Warren Park" indicates that 7 applicants from Warren Park's catchment which was originally associated to Humbercrest were redirected to George Syme and 6 accepted the placement. Where multiple redirection sites were utilized, originally associated French schools are in brackets in the comments column. A complete list of schools offering either French Immersion or Extended French programs can be found on the TDSB public website.

Guiding principles for redirection include: redirecting students as a group based on English home school <u>and</u> redirecting to closest FI or EF site with capacity.

While the tables for each of the four programs show numbers at the entry point, the last table in this report shows the total enrolment in these programs from SK to Grade 12. There consistently has been an increase in participation in French programs since amalgamation.

The report will be shared with the French as a Second Language Advisory Committee (FSLAC).
