Anti-Sex Trafficking

Human trafficking involves manipulation, deception, force, cohesion, fraud and is facilitated by a third party. It thrives in situations of unequal power and inequity.

This makes **consent** central to this issue and an important one to explore when dealing with exploitation or any form of sexual violence.


