

Early French Immersion Application Submission

To begin the application process, you must generate a PARS ID number. This number will be used to submit the application, check the status of your application and to accept placement once it is offered.

- **Step 1** - Select the “Early French Immersion Program” from the drop-down menu.
- **Step 2** - Select “My child is: Not a TDSB student”
- **Step 3** - Click the orange link above the PARS ID window that reads “Click here if you do not have a PARS ID”
- **Step 4** - Follow the prompts to enter the information requested.
- **Step 5** - Make note of the PARS ID once it is generated and then **click “Continue Application”**.
- **Step 6** - Select “Standard Application” or “Sibling Option”. The sibling option is for families with an older child already attending Early French Immersion.
- **Step 7** - Verify the program selection and your email address and **click “Submit”**. You will receive an email confirming the submission. Please check your inbox (including junk mail) for that email message. The following message should appear on the screen:

- **Step 8** - After the deadline has passed, offers of placement will be sent out to all on-time applicants using the email address you provide. You must take action to accept that offer of placement.
- **Step 9** - During the month of February, you will receive an email to the address you have provided containing a link unique to your application that will allow you to register formally at the French Immersion school. This email will only be sent to those who have accepted the offer of placement earlier in the process.
